The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Treasurer Dana Davis met with the Board to discuss the bond coverage for the treasurer's office for the renewal report.

Horton gave a report on the ambulance meeting he attended.

The Board reviewed the monthly expense reports for the county.

The Board approved the claims for Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claim List" dated January 7, 2016.

Angela Green met with the Board in regard to radon action month. January is designated as National Radon Action Month across the United States.
