The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Assessor Sharon Dalton visited with the Board in regard to Frontier requesting information from our GIS system. Dalton didn't think our system had the information that they needed. Dalton will see if E911 has what they want and if they don't she will return to see what action Taylor County will take on selling information from our system.

The Board approved the claim to Agrivision for \$14.94 for conservation parts.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve and sign the "Wellness Program Agreement between the Iowa State Association of Counties (ISAC) and Taylor County". The ISAC enhanced wellness program will include comprehensive consulting services and Online Lifestyle Management programs as well as an incentive program to both counties and policy holders during the plan year of 2016. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the "Equipment Disposal Form" for the secondary road department. The form was for a rental excavator that was returned to the vender.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
