The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Joan Gallagher met with the Board for approval of a "Equipment Disposal Form" for a wooden desk in the basement of the courthouse. The Board approved for the desk to be moved out and anyone that wanted it could haul it away.

Horton discussed the sanitary landfill meeting he attended.

The Board received two applications for the position of Weed Commissioner. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to offer the job to William Daleske at \$15.00 per hour as needed. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claims List" dated January 28, 2016.

Ambrose left the meeting at 10:20 a.m.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve Resolution **2016-12**. This resolution designates, authorizes and empowers Eldon Rike, the County Engineer of Taylor County, Iowa, on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of Taylor County to execute the certification of completion of work and final acceptance thereof in accordance with plans and specifications in connection with all Farm-to-Market and Federal or State aid construction projects in this county. The motion carried 2-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
