The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the health insurance pay-out for Jordan Jenkins.

Sheriff Josh Weed and Mark Wooderson from Caliber met with the Board in regard to new software for the sheriff's department. Discussion was held on the different quotes from Caliber. Taylor County could apply for a 911 grant to cover some of the costs for \$72,397.30. The civil paper portion of the software will not be considered at this time. Wooderson will get an updated quote with the changes included. No action was taken at this time.

The Board tabled setting the date for the sale of county owned property until next month.

The Board approved the "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Southern Iowa Rural Water Association for Section 17 & 18 for Polk Township.
