The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board discussed the FY2017 EMS Grant. Baker will email Adam Wainwright to see if he could meet with the Board to discuss the line items.

The Board set April 18<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. for a public hearing to adopt Ordinance #35 Titled: Readopting the existing county codes and amending and/or repealing certain portions therein. The purpose of this ordinance is to comply with Section 331.302 of the Code of Iowa, which requires that once every five years a county shall compile its code of ordinances.

A motion was Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve Resolution **2016-15**. This resolution is to notify the treasurer to transfer from the Rural Service Fund \$61,917.42 to the Secondary Road Fund. This amount includes \$5,688.79 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales & Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

Assessor Sharon Dalton discussed bond insurance with the Board. The Chief Deputy Assessor position was also discussed. These issues will be discussed at the next Assessor Conference Board meeting.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
