The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Adam Wainwright, Cindy Wall and Tommy Mothershead met with the Board to discuss the EMS Grant for fiscal year ending 2017. This grant has been cut to \$3,913.00. A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to apply and approve for submitting the FY2017 EMS Grant Application for \$3,913.00. The motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose reported some items that need to be addressed. The light on the west side of the courthouse is not working. Murphy will notify Drake Electric. The floor upstairs on third floor also needs to be fixed. Andy Thomas was notified.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Claim Publishing List" dated April 7, 2016.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the paving contract with Concrete Impressions, L.L.C. for Project No.: LFM-CO87(1)-87, paving at the Law Enforcement Center for \$73,704.38. The motion carried.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
