The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Horton gave a report of the Taylor County EMS meeting he attended.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the Agreement between Taylor County and Bedford Community School to continue to share a full-time informational technology operations management position. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Claim Publishing List" dated April 21, 2016.

The Board set May 23rd at 10:00 a.m. for a budget amendment public hearing.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approved the "Application of use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Frontier Communications for Grove and Marshall Townships north of Sharpsburg. The motion carried 3-0.
