The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Cheryl Wallace updated the Board on the repairs needed to the treasurer's furnace.

A motion was made by Murphy and second by Ambrose to approve the "Agreement for Multicounty County Collection of Delinquent Court Obligations". This agreement will devote the appropriate administrative resources for Ringgold, Taylor, Fremont and Adams County to comply with their obligations to collect delinquent court debt, pursuant to Iowa Code 602.8701 (4)€(2) and Chapter 28E. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the county monthly expense reports for April and discussed the items that will need to be amended in the May 23rd budget amendment.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
