The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the claims to Bankers Trust for \$266,702.50 for the Law Enforcement loan payment and \$618,330.00 for the county road bond loan payment.

Belinda Ogle and Joan Gallagher met with the Board in regard to controlling the mosquitoes to help prevent the Zika virus. Discussion was held on cleaning up old tires and each town to do spraying to control the mosquitoes. Gallagher will start some education programs. Ogle contacted Entire Recycling Company in Rockport, Missouri and their cost would be \$90 a ton to take old tires. No action was taken at this time.

Gallagher left the meeting and Ogle discussed the mitigation plan. The Board worked on the worksheets for the next meeting.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve the "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Farmers Mutual Telephone for Section 23 of Nodaway Township. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
