The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Shilo Leonard and Jamie Brown from the Preschool Board met with the Board in regard to purchasing the preschool building from Taylor County. The Board said that they would sell to the preschool for \$75,000 to be paid in three installments with no interest. Brown and Leonard will talk to the other board members and will get back to the Board.

Informational Technology Director Martin Jones visited with the Board in regard to internet service. No action was taken at this time.

Randy Kernan visited with the Board in regard to trays for the metal shelves for the Law Enforcement Center. Horton will purchase one.

Sheriff Josh Weed recommended Jeremy Stenda for the deputy sheriff position. Horton made a motion and seconded by Murphy to approve Weed's recommended.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve Resolution **2015-18**. This 28E Agreement amends to provide more flexibility and reflect the broader activities of the 28E entity, including: changing the entity's name to Iowa Counties Technology Services; removing the cap on the number of members of the Advisory Committee; allowing for a fee schedule; and allowing the option to have MHDS Regions and other non-county entities as members. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board gave approval for hiring temporary help to fill in for vacations for janitorial services at \$12 an hour.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
