The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Randy Kernen, Kevin Cabbage and Frank Sefrit met with the Board in regard to communication information for the law enforcement center project site. The radio tower was discussed. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to bring fiber to the Law Enforcement Center from Farmers Mutual Telephone Co. The motion carried 3-0.

County Attorney Clint Spurrier met with the Board to answer some questions they had about selling county owned property.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claims List" dated June 4, 2015.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board with an employment contract. The contract was the same as last year except for the 4% increase in salary. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the contract.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to accept the bid from SecureTech for a security system for the courthouse. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
