The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Angela Green met with the Board. Lillian Worth had contacted Green in regard to a property in Section 30 of Grove Township. Worth would like to sell this piece of land to the county for a landfill. No action was taken at this time.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve Departmental Appropriation Resolution **2016-19** to transfer \$167.00 from account 02000-01410-261-31 to account 02000-01110-426-28 in order to pay additional medical examiner expense. The motion carried 3-0.

Horton gave a report on the status of the preschool building.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claim List" dated June 16, 2016.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the 2016 Granular Surfacing Agreement between Taylor County and Schildberg Construction Company for an estimated quantity of placed 9739 ton of 1" Class D Road Stone for \$168,673.40. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
