The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Sheriff Josh Weed discussed applicants for the deputy sheriff position. No action was taken

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the "Enforcement Service Agreement between the City of Clearfield and Taylor County". The City of Clearfield agrees to pay Taylor County the sum of \$371.00 per month for law enforcement services effective for a term of one year. The motion carried 3-0.

Jim Rowe visited with the Board in regard to the big tree that fell in the court yard. He said that they could get to it later this week.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the "Application for Disabled Veteran's Homestead Tax Credit" for Gene Daniels. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution **2015-20**. This resolution transfers \$59,301.37 from the Rural Service Fund and \$26,487.00 from the General Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund. This amount includes \$5,456.19 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales & Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
