The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Ambrose gave a report of the Emergency Management meeting he attended.

The Board approved the "Equipment Disposal Form" for the conservation department for a HP Photosmart C7280, a HP deskjet 950C and a Dell Computer Dimension L Series.

The Board approved the claim to the General Basic Fund to correct the fund on warrant #108858 for \$27,714.10.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the following compensation estimate for Project No. BROS-CO87(50)—8J-87; William H. Coats for \$1,616.65 for .35 acres in the W ½ E ½ of the fractional Section 4, T-68N, R-35W of the 5th P.M; Jay & Mary Ellen Sunderman for \$1,200.94 for .26 acres in the SE ¼ SW ¼ and SW ¼ SE ¼ of Section 34, T69N, R-35W. For Project No. BROS-CO87(51)—8J-87- M & B Farms, Inc. for \$1,755.22 for .38 acres in the SW ¼ SW ¼ of Section 4, T-70N, R-34W; and John M & Terri L. Schuler for \$1,570.46 for .34 acres in the SE ¼ SE ¼ of Section 5, T70N, R-34W. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
