

July 30, 2015

The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Ambrose gave a report of the South Central Iowa Regional E911 board meeting he attended.

Paige Beason discussed the inventory list with the Board.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve **Resolution 2016-02**. This resolution is to notify the treasurer to transfer \$61,917.42 from the Rural Service Fund to the Secondary Road Fund. This amount includes \$5,456.19 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales & Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claim List" dated July 30, 2015.

Sheriff Josh Weed discussed the start date of his part time jailer going full time with the Board. Weed will talk with his employee concerning the vacation and start date.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the "Application for use of Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Windstream Iowa Communications, Inc. for Section 5, 3.5 miles from the City of Gravity. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
