The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy and Taylor County Deputy Auditor Paige Beason present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Board approved claim to EL Crawford \$125,974.75 for payment # 12 and Storey Kenworthy/Matt Parrott \$347.38 for warrant stock.

Board discussed Courtyard and Law Enforcement Center yard care with Pat Blacketer. Pat will prepare an estimate and meet again with the Board on Thursday, August 11th.

Board voted on the City of Blockton's request to have the City of Blockton Local Sales and Service Tax Measure to be placed on the November 3, 2015 City Election Ballot. Motion was made by Doug Horton and seconded by Charles Ambrose to approve. The motion carried 3-0.
