The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Cheryl Wallace visited with the Board in regard to security when the law enforcement center moves to the new location. A plan was set up for checking out the courthouse key. Wallace also discussed concerns with the west doors of the courthouse. She has called Maryville Glass but will be awhile before they can get to it. No action was taken.

Betty Marxen visited with the Board about abating the taxes due on Pursuit of Independence Inc. on parcel 001402000208000. Assessor Sharon Dalton joined the meeting and explain the process of the City of Lenox abatement process. Before, the city said not to abate the taxes until the first full assessment year so that the taxpayer would get full benefit of the 5 year abatement. Marxen said they have been approved for tax exempt status and would no longer owe taxes and the City of Lenox abatement should have covered the taxes for 2014. The Board will discuss it further and no action was taken at this time.

Marxen explained the problems with Manage Care coming to Iowa for mental health services.

The Law Enforcement Center Project was discussed. No action was taken at this time.

Jim Rowe met with the Board. Rowe will see that a grader will level the ground at the Law Enforcement Center. He will contact Pat Blacketer to coordinate the timing.

The Board gave permission for the sheriff to purchase new mattresses for the new law enforcement center.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
