

August 27, 2015

The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Sheriff Josh Weed discussed the trays for the radio communications. Weed thought that he could get some reimbursement money from E911.

The Board received a bid from JBW Home Remodeling for \$750.00 plus materials for repairs to the south entrance. The Board agreed to proceed with the repairs.

Joan Gallagher met with the Board. She voiced her concerns with the request from the Bedford Chamber to put a vending machine being added to the courthouse. Her office does sell pop and bottled water out of her office. The Board did not realize that the nurses had soda available. The Board will decline the offer to put a vending machine in the courthouse.

Gallagher has been getting prices but would like more time to search. She has \$12,751.59 in an account for administrative claiming that can be used for a car. Gallagher will do more research and get back with prices.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve **Resolution 2016-03**. This resolution transfers \$61,917.42 from the rural service fund to the secondary road fund. This amount includes \$5,456.19 deposited in the rural service fund by local option sales and services tax. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claim to Iowa Department of Inspections & Appeals for the jail inspection for \$100.00 that was written on August 26, 2015.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County dated August 27, 2015 as listed in the "Claim Publishing List".

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
