The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board discussed the results of the punch list at the Law Enforcement Center.

The Board approved the health insurance pay out for Joan Gallagher for quarter ending June 30, 2015.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board with a federal aid agreement for the bridge located 1 mile east of Diamond Ave at 220th Street with a start date of November 2015. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the Iowa Department of Transportation Federal-aid Agreement for a County Highway Bridge Program Project, Project No. BROS-CO87(50)—8J-87 for a FHWA Structure Number: 322100 for a preliminary estimated total cost of \$500,000.00. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Southern Iowa Rural Water Association for Section 17 in Polk Township. The motion carried 3-0.

Horton gave a report on the courthouse security meeting he attended. Mick Ware joined the meeting and the courthouse yard light was discussed. The Board will get someone to put a new light on the east side of the courthouse.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
