

September 10, 2015

The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Jim McAlpin met with the Board. He would like to thank the county for keeping the road mowed up. He asked about the status of the road work at New Market. The Board said that they have contracted the work but haven't heard when they will be starting.

Martin Jones met with the Board in regard to security at the courthouse. SecureTech does not do cameras. The motion detectors are \$280.00. Employees will go to sheriff's office to get a key.

Ambrose explained that one building at the secondary road department and the conservation office was missed for the new wireless AP devices. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the FMTC quote to install the devices for \$1,091.48. The motion carried 3-0.

Joan Gallagher met with the Board. Gallagher found a 2013 Fusion at Tri-State for \$18,600 to replace the 2006 Ford Taurus. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve for Gallagher to purchase the car. The motion carried 3-0. The Board will take seal bids for the 2006 Ford Taurus until September 28<sup>th</sup>.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the 2015 Urban Renewal Report. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claims List" dated September 10, 2015.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. The Board approved the "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for the following: Windstream Iowa Communications, Inc. for Section 31 of Washington Township; Grand River Mutual Telephone for Section 29 of Jefferson Township; and Southern Iowa Rural Water Association for Section 26 of Gay Township. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the three applications. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
