The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy and Taylor County Deputy Auditor Paige Beason present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the, "Publishing Claims List", dated September 24th, 2015.

Public Health advised that they had a telephone die and wanted to know what to do with not having a replacement available, the board is looking into options.
