The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present. Doug Horton was absent.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Ambrose reported that he put an article in both papers explaining that the supervisors were not against wind energy coming into Taylor County.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve the contract between Taylor County and Aleck Edwin Pafford to provide training for Pafford as a deputy and to specify the consideration that Pafford provide the county in return for training. The motion carried 2-0.

Sheriff Josh Weed met with the Board. Weed received a bid for a cell phone booster from High Tech for 1554.96 for the Law Enforcement Center. The Board approved this purchase.

Murphy gave a report on the Mental Health and Case Management meetings he attended.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
