The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve **Resolution 2016-05**. This resolution transfers \$123,834.84 from the Rural Service Fund to the Secondary Road Fund which includes \$10,912.38 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales and Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the monthly expense reports for the county.

Jim Rowe reported that he rented another back hoe for the secondary road department.

Jim Helm called in to ask for the Taylor Ridge Estate sign to be removed. The Secondary Road Department will do this.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board in regard to an application for utility permit. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the permit for Windstream Iowa Communications, Inc. in Section 24 of Grant Township. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
