The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Horton gave a report on the ambulance board meeting he attended.

Items at the law enforcement center that were not finished were discussed.

The Board discussed the draft of the proposed personnel policy. The Board directed the auditor to send a copy to all departments for review. The department heads will have until December 17<sup>th</sup> to review and report back to the supervisors their comments.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board with an "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Chris McKay for Section 18 in Mason Township. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the application. The motion carried 3-0.

Sheriff Josh Weed visited with the Board in regard to the items that need attention at the law enforcement center. The cameras have been ordered. The fan in the exercise room has water in it that wasn't on the original list.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
