The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the claim to Hy-Vee for \$521.93 for inmate food and supplies and to ABC Plumbing for \$914.00 for two toilets and installation.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. The Board discussed the proposed secondary road union contract. The Board held a phone conference with Union Representative Mark Mann in regard to the union contract. The Board would like a one year contract but the union would like a 3% increase. Another date will be set for mediation.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the "Application for Use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Betty Simpson for Section 6 of Dallas Township. The motion carried 3-0.

Sheriff Josh Weed visited with the Board in regard to snow removal for the law enforcement center. The Board will take bids until December 16th at 4:30 p.m.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
