

April 18, 2016

The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve **Resolution 2016-16**. This resolution is to notify the treasurer to transfer from the Rural Service Fund to the Secondary Road Fund \$61,917.42. This amount includes \$4,955.20 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales & Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

Chairman Doug Horton opened the public hearing for Taylor County Ordinance No. 35 for readopting the existing county codes and amending and/or repealing certain portions therein, Taylor County, Iowa. There was no one from the public present. There were no written or oral comments received. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to close the public hearing. The motion carried 3-0. A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to suspend the second and third readings of the Ordinance #35 and adopt said ordinance. The motion carried 3-0.

Joan Gallagher gave the Board a report of the status of the partnership of the Taylor and Adam Counties Public Health Departments.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. The Board approved the "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Farmers Mutual Telephone Company in Mason, Polk and Dallas Townships. Rike also discussed an amendment for his department.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
