The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Weed Commissioner Report that was due on December 31st has not been filed yet. The Board contacted the previous weed commissioner to see why this report hasn't been filed. He stated he had filed in February. Since the state does not show where it was filed, Bill Daleske will follow up on filing the report.

Zeb Schuelke found out from the treasurer's office that the taxes for 1001 Main Street could not be abated. No action was taken.

Sheriff Josh Weed and IT Director Martin Jones discussed the sheriff's office computer software and server costs with the Board. Weed discussed other potential budget amendments for his office.

Randy Kernen visited with the Board in regard to the Blockton Fire repeater that will be placed on the Conway water tower. The agreement with SIRWA for use of the Conway water tower was discussed and placed on Thursday's agenda for approval.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
