The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Bonnie Godden and Matt Churchill we present to ask to Board to abate the taxes on the building owned by Chris McMorrان. The city is in the process of acquiring this building to be demolished. The property currently has back taxes, penalties, interest, and a special assessment. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy that upon time the City of Bedford acquires the property all back taxes, penalties, interest and the special assessment will be forgiven as long as the city follows through with demolition and complete cleanup of the property. Motion carried 3-0.
