The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve the Annual Urban Rev Report. The motion carried 3-0.

Auditor Baker reviewed the visit from Ed Morrison from Iowa Municipalities Workers' Compensation Association. A "Five Year History Report" was discussed.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the "EMS Service Affiliation Agreement" between the Taylor County Ambulance Service and the City of Blockton, on behalf of Blockton EMS for satellite ambulance service. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Claim Publishing List" dated August 25, 2016.

Jeffrey Heil from Northland Securities Inc. met with the Board in regard to researching the possibility of refinancing Taylor County's bonds to save interest money.

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. The Board approved the "Application for Use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Windstream Iowa Communications Inc. for Section 27 & 28 in Washington Township.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
