The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Murphy reported on the Trolley Meeting he attended.

Stan Mattas stopped by to ask the Board to no make any changes in the Master Matrix. Other counties in the area have been approached to put control back in the counties hands instead of the DNR. The Board shared Stan feeling that these decisions are better left to the state agencies.

Sheriff, Josh Weed presented the agreement to send Trevor Calfee to the Law Enforcement Academy. The projected cost is \$17,120.00 and funds would have to be repaid if Officer Calfee left employment with the county within 48 months. Officer Calfee is scheduled to complete the academy October 27, 2017. A motion was made by Ambrose seconded by Murphy to approve the agreement with Officer Calfee. Motion carried 3-0.

Jim Rowe visited with the Board about road concerns on 210th St.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution 2018-02. At the intersection of 235th St. and Quail Ave. to remove the stop signs at the north and south approaches and add stop signs at the east west approaches. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
