The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the claim to Lenox Municipal Utilities for \$240.02.

Murphy gave a report on the Southwest Trolley meeting he attended.

The Board approved the "Equipment Disposal Form" for a 1973 Ford Pickup that belonged to the conservation department.

The Board approved the homesteads and militaries for the FY2017-2018 tax year except for the military exemption on parcel 092-0805000014000 due to not serving in an eligible service period.

The Board approved the annual "Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification" report from the sheriff's department.
