The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the claim to the U.S. Postmaster for \$168.00.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the Compensation Board's recommendation of a 3% increase for all elected officers across the board. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve the Compensation Board's recommendation to give all eligible elected officials to receive longevity on regular working hours (2080/1950 hours) at the rate as other Taylor County employees described in the personnel policy. The motion carried 5-0.

Deb Goldsmith and Jan Beach-Sickels met with the Board to review the ambulance budget.

Joan Gallagher met with the Board for approval for two "Equipment Disposal Forms" for two typewriter stands. The Board gave approval for both.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
