

December 28, 2015

The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the health insurance pay out for Sue Cox.

The Board received a bid from Dalton Snow Removal for \$90 per snow for the Law Enforcement Center. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to accept this bid for snow removal. The motion carried 3-0.

Employees met with the Board in regard to the increase in health insurance premiums of 8.82%. Present were Julie Robinson, Tyler Couch, Daniel Wyckoff, Belinda Ogle, Dana Davis, Rick Sheley, Sue Cox, Bonny Baker, Sharon Dalton, Marian Dowling, Tara Cummings, Sandy Davison and Joan Gallagher. The three options are for the county to pay it, have the employees to contribute or raise the deductible. No action was taken at this time.

A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to offer Plan 10 to all employees. This plan would increase the deductible from \$750 to \$1000. If the employee wanted to continue with Plan 9, they will have to contribute \$25 a month toward the plan for health insurance. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Publishing Claims List" dated December 28, 2015.

Jim Rowe and Randy Peterman met with the Board in regard to new trucks. One quote received for the truck and body would be \$185,603. Rowe will give to the County Engineer to review the budget.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
