The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy, and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting also approved the minutes of the last meeting.

The Board approved the claims to be paid.

Joan Gallagher joined the meeting and Nick Fehring via phone. The status of the new joint Conservation/Sanitarian Position was discussed.

CHI Health Mercy Corning approached the Board with an agreement to provide discounted services to our inmates. When an inmate is in the Taylor County Jail all medical expenses are up to the county if the individual is not covered by private insurance, many are not. Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve the agreement with CHI for inmate health care. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board set January 4th at 10:00 a.m. for the public hearing on the proposed budget amendment.
