The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bonny Baker present. Auditor Elect Bethany Murphy was also present.

Ambrose gave a report of the meeting he attended at the Law Enforcement Center with representatives from the Clarinda Correction Facility and the sheriff's department.

The Board approved the Weed Commissioner's Report for fiscal year 2016.

The Board approved the claims against Taylor County as listed in the "Claim Publishing List" dated December 29, 2016.

The Board discussed placing a light on the flag in the courtyard. Murphy received a bid from Drake Electric for \$450. Murphy will contact Drake and start the process.

Compensation Board Chairman Paul Ackley met with the Board. He reported on the recommendation from the Compensation Board for salaries for the elected officials for FY2018 as follows:

A 3% increase for all elected officers across the board and to receive longevity on regular working hours (2080/1950 hours) at the same rate as other Taylor County employees described in the personnel policy. No action taken at this time.

No action was taken on the Proclamation Request Memorandum for Taylor County School Choice Week at this time.

Chairman Horton opened the public hearing for a budget amendment. Discussion was held on the proposed amendment. A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to close the public hearing. The motion carried 3-0. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve the budget amendment as published. The motion carried 3-0.

County Engineer Eldon Rike and Jim Rowe met with the Board in regard to county right of way concerns. The Board will consult with County Attorney Clint Spurrier about this matter.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
