Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to add a hand write to the agenda for the Conservation Department credit card bill. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved the agenda for today's meeting also approved the minutes of the last meeting.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve the hand written warrants for Visa Card Services for \$122.77 and Kansas Highway Patrol Fleet Sales for \$18,500.00. Motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution 2018-10. This resolution is concerned with recent rapid rise in overuse of Opioid medications. Motion carried 3-0.

Safety Director, Mick Ware visited with the Board on the new Safety Manual the county is working on implementing. Ware also addressed the Board as EMA Director about installing helipads in every community. Ware thinks it is very important to have a designated spot in every community for an emergency helicopter to land. There were two bids for the construction received for one pad were; 3D Construction for \$16,651.63 and David Spencer for \$16,100.00. The Board will check into this more before making any decision.
