The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Debbie Tillman and Dan Jordan met with the Board about the Lenox Neighborhood Center. They asked the Board for their continued support as well as additional funds for the planned new addition.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution 2017-11 to transfer \$66,357.50 from Rural Services Fund to Secondary Roads Fund. This transfer includes \$6,513.97 from Local Option Sales & Service Tax. Motion carried 3-0.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve Resolution 2017-12 to reappoint Chris England to continue to represent Taylor County on the Board of Commissioners of the Southern Iowa Regional Housing Authority. Motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve the credit card list and limits for the Secondary Roads Department. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board continued to review the budget for FY18.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
