The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve the minutes of the last meeting and the agenda for today. Motion carried 3-0.

Murphy gave a report on the RC&D meeting he attended.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve the longevity for elected officers at the same rate as other Taylor County employees as described in the personnel policy. Motion carried 3-0.

Kelly Butts for Connections Area Agency on Aging, explaining what services they provide to communities in Taylor County.

The Board discussed the funding for the Lenox Development Corporation on the old Bunn Building project. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Horton to commit \$25,000.00 to the project contingent on, the City of Lenox matching the funds dollar for dollar up to a max of \$25, 000.00. These funds will come from the Local Option Sales and Service Tax. The Board feels like this will be a project worth supporting, and will look at these projects on a case by case basis. Motion carried 2-1.

The Board visited with Harold Johnston on snow removal at the Courthouse. Mr. Johnston will see that all sidewalks are snow free.

The Board had a conference call with Adams County Board of Supervisors. The Board discussed the EMS boundary line, which stop at the county line. The Board would like to get the ball rolling to get these lines changed to better serve the citizens of both counties. The Board would like these lines to fallow the fire district lines. This will be brought up at the next E911 Board meeting.

The Board continued working on the FY19 budget.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
