The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

A motion was made by Ambrose and seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution 2017-10. This resolution transfers \$66,357.50 from Rural Service Fund to the Secondary Road Fund. This amount includes \$6,513.96 deposited in the Rural Service fund by Local Option Sales and Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

Recorder, Rick Sheley met with the Board to present his budget for FY18.

Lisa Wolfe and Jan Beach-Sickels came before the Board to present the Taylor County Ambulance budget for FY18.

Dwayne Cason met with the Board to discuss the condition of his road. Jim Rowe was present and the Board will work and a solution for the problem.

Sheriff, Josh Weed presented his budget to the Board for FY18.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to continue the agreement with Bi-State Electronics for the Sheriff's Department. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
