The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to approve Resolution 2017-08. This Resolution allows Taylor County to participate in the planning and development programs of the Southern Iowa Council of Governments. The motion carried 3-0.

Conservation Director Nick Fehring met with the board. Paula Fehring, Conservation Board Member resigned her position on the board. The Board will appoint someone to fill Paula's unexpired term.

The Board started working on the budget for FY18.

Eldon Rike, Jim Rowe and Randy Peterman were present to present quotes for new motor graders. Three bids were received from the following: John Deere \$188,536.27; John Deere \$202,230.35; and Ziegler CAT \$205,906.00. A motion was made by Murphy seconded by Ambrose to accept the bid from Ziegler Cat for \$205,906.00 for a 2017 motor grader. The motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
