The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy and County Deputy Auditor Paige Beason present.

After roll call the Board voted to add to the agenda the request to approve the liquor license for Across the Border Raid. The Board then moved to approve the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Board approved claims to Frontier Communications for Assessor's Office, local service \$ 86.38 and long distance \$ 11.08.

Secondary Roads Department was not present during today's meeting.

Board voted to add to the agenda the liquor license for Across the Border Raid. Motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve the Across the Border Raid Class B Liquor License which includes Beer and Wine Cooler sales.

Board toured the courtyard to observe the down tree limb reported by Cheryl Wallace. Jerry Murphy will return tomorrow with a chain saw to cut and remove the limb.

Present for the Monthly Law Enforcement Center Project Meeting were the following: Bill Huey from Prochaska & Associates, Dustin Pittman from EL Crawford Construction, Shawn Kidell from R/S Electric and Sheriff Josh Weed. Dustin reviewed work completed from last meeting and discussed items needing coordination from Taylor County. Bill presented the Board with a Progress Budget Summary for review. Next meeting is tentatively scheduled for August 20th.

Sheriff Josh Weed reported that Kenny Spencer with the City of Bedford had received the new Booster Pump for the Law Enforcement Facility on Tuesday, July 14th. Coordination is in progress for delivery and set up.
