The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Treasurer Dana Davis reviewed the semiannual report with the Board.

Two bids were received from Fine Services for \$980.00 and Green Valley Pest Control & Lawn Care for \$975.00 for termite treatment for the courthouse annex. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Ambrose to hire Green Valley Pest Control for treatment of the courthouse annex. The motion carried 3-0.

The contract between the Iowa Department of Public Health and Taylor County for Fiscal Year 2017 was discussed. The Taylor County EMS Committee will meet on July 19th and will review the agreement with the Board taking action on July 21st.

The Board approved the claims for Murphy Heavy Contracting for \$49,809.73 and to Gus Construction for \$214,304.11.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
