The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

Taylor County Conservation Director, Nick Fehring met with the Board on purchase of playground equipment for Wilson's Lake. Nick applied and received a grant from Taylor County Endowment Foundation for \$10,000.00 this is a matching grant and the county would be responsible for the other \$10,000.00. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to purchase the playground equipment for \$20,000.00 with \$10,000.00 from the Local Option Sales and Service Tax funds and \$10,000.00 from the Endowment Grant. Motion carried 3-0.

Paul Longfellow phoned into the Board with road concerns.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to purchase a 2005 Yale 4945 forklift for \$13,850.00 from Burr Farm Machinery Company. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
