The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose, Doug Horton and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Belinda Ogle gave the Board three quotes for tire disposal. The Board reviewed the quotes but no action was taken at this time.

Ambrose gave a report on the driveway at the Law Enforcement Center.

Horton gave a report of the status of the variance for the building at 805 E. Home Ave, in Lenox.

Andy Thomas has fixed the broken window at the very top of the courthouse. He suggested that all the windows be repaired. Thomas will get an estimate of what the cost would be and let the Board know.

The Board canvassed the votes cast at the June 7, 2016 Primary Election and found the count correct as reported. The Board declared the following duly nominated for the following offices on the November 8, 2016 General Election:

County Engineer Eldon Rike met with the Board. The Board approved the claim to Gus Construction Company for \$95,503.68 for BROS-CO87(51)—8J-87.

The Board approved the "Application for use of Road Right of Way for Utilities Accommodation" for Frontier Communications of Iowa, Inc. in Section 6 of Holt Township.
