The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Treasurer, Dana Davis presented the 28E agreement between the DOT and Taylor County. Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to continue the agreement with the DOT. Motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution 2017-20 transferring funds from account 01000 01000 635 05 to 01000 01110 426 28 in the amount of \$250.00. Motion carried 3-0.

Murphy gave a report on the Hungry Cannon's Meeting he attended.

Sharon Dalton asked the Board for an amount to charge companies wanting the county's GIS shape files. The Board agreed the amount should be set at \$100.00.

Joan Gallagher and Angela Green joined the meeting.

Rick and Linda Nelson were present with concerns about their septic system. They will have to discuss their concerns with the Board of Health, who governs the Environmental Health Department.

Eldon Rike was present to discuss a possible new maintainer shed. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to allow Eldon Rike to negotiate on the price of the land with Jeff Soulsby for a quarter of an acre. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
