

March 23, 2017

The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve Resolution 2017-16 to transfer \$66,357.50 from Rural Services Fund to Secondary Roads Fund. This transfer includes \$5,507.98 from Local Option Sales & Service Tax. Motion carried 3-0.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve the County Medical Providers. The Board designated CHI Clinic in Bedford and Lenox and SSM Hardin Medical Clinic in Bedford. Motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to make a new inventory procedure. The county will now only keep track of items over the \$500.00 threshold. Motion carried 3-0.

Horton gave a report on the Landfill Committee.

Eldon Rike presented the Board with a proposal for 30 miles of new rock to be hauled and spread by Schildburg Construction Company.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to approve the proposal for the 30 miles of new rock. This will put 7514 tons of new rock on Taylor County Roads. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
