The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

Randy Kernan and Josh Weed were present. Randy presented to the Board an estimate of what it was going to take to fix the paging system. The Board agreed to pay for the part as the labor is included in Randy's service contract with the county.

Rick Nelson talked with the Board on Veterans Affairs concerns.

Murphy made a motion seconded by Ambrose to approve the Compensation Boards recommended increase for elected officials at the 3%. The new salary for the Auditor, Treasurer and Recorder is be \$45,474.41 for the Sheriff \$56,800.01 for the County Attorney \$59,309.78 for the Fiscal year 2018. The Board chose not that take their recommended salary increase. Motion carried 3-0.

Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to renew the health insurance plan for the County. There were no changes to this plan. Motion carried 3-0.

Angela Green joined the meeting.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
