The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Doug Horton, Charles Ambrose, Jerry Murphy and County Auditor Bethany Murphy present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes for the last meeting.

The Board reviewed the claims and approved for payment.

Clint Spurrier met with the Board on writing an agreement between the Taylor County Ambulance and the Taylor County Sheriff's Department.

Eldon Rike and Jim Rowe met with the Board. They had a bid from Stiver's Ford for \$32,071.00. This bid was to replace the truck ordered from Creston Automotive for \$27,200.00 that had been delivered wrong twice. The Board is working on renegotiating cost on the truck with Creston Automotive.

They also presented bids for a Diamond Brush cutter Mower for \$48,641.00 and a John Deere 6130M for \$85,400.00. Both are not available till after the new fiscal year in July, but would need to be ordered to get first available. Ambrose made a motion seconded by Murphy to allow the ordering of the tractor and mower, both will not be paid for until delivered. Motion carried 3-0.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
