The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Friday due to the Board attending training on Thursday, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Pat Blacketer met with the Board to ask for financial help for the proposed skate park that will be built in Bibbins Park in Bedford. They have around \$2,300 so far in addition to several people will be donating labor or at cost. No action was taken at this time.

Ambrose discussed the proposed contract with the City of Lenox for law enforcement. Sheriff Josh Weed will meet with the Board on Thursday.

The Board called Ewart Insurance in regard to sensitivity testing on the smoke detectors and duct smoke detectors on the fire alarm system at the preschool building in Lenox. Ewart Insurance will do some research and get back to the Board.

The Board called Ed Townsend in regard to the Weed Commissioner conference in March. Townsend was not sure he was going to attend. The Board asked that he get in touch with Jim Winemiller if he was not attending.

The Board approved for the request of the use of courthouse restrooms for the tractor drive that was coming through Bedford on June 13<sup>th</sup>. Ambrose volunteered to open the courthouse during this time.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
