The Taylor County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, with Doug Horton, Jerry Murphy, Charles Ambrose and County Auditor Bonny Baker present.

After roll call the Board approved the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes of the last meeting.

Lydia Brumfield, Matura met with the Board in regard to a salary increase for her staff. A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve a \$1.00 an hour increase for Faye Jean Hinshaw effective March 4, 2015. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board approved a claim to Hy-Vee for \$64.29.

A motion was made by Murphy and seconded by Horton to approve Secondary Road Transfer Resolution **2015-14**. This resolution transfers \$118,602.66 from the Rural Service Fund to the Secondary Road Fund. This amount includes \$10,443.42 deposited in the Rural Service Fund by Local Option Sales & Services Tax. The motion carried 3-0.

Sheriff Josh Weed met with the Board. A motion was made by Horton and seconded by Murphy to approve the hire of Aleck Pafford to fill the position of deputy sheriff for the Lenox City Law Enforcement Contract. The motion carried 3-0.

Discussion was held on the master control console for the new law enforcement center. The Board gave Josh permission to get some quotes.

No further business came before the Board at this time and the meeting adjourned subject to call.
